Please take this information to the music store when you get your instrument.
You will be responsible for the following instrument and accessories.

Recommended Flute Brand/Model-Rent or Purchase from Music Store:

Yamaha YFL281S

There are other choices, but these models are the best overall value.

AVOID:

Please avoid any instrument that you are unable to open and view before purchase. Inferior instruments are available at retail stores and online. An inferior instrument will hinder success and frustrate your child.

Required Accessories-Purchase from Music Store:

Silk cleaning swab (to clean the inside of the instrument after each use)

Aluminum or Wooden flute cleaning rod (used to run the swab through flute)

Polish cloth-untreated (used to polish flutes exterior)

Rhythm Master Book 1, Flute by J.R. McEntyre & Harry Haines

Folding Music Stand (This helps ensure proper playing technique while practicing at home)

zipper pencil pouch & pencils

Where to buy:

As with any purchase, it is best to explore as many options as possible before you buy. Here are a few options for you, please feel free to call or email if you have any questions.

Local Stores:

Local stores are the best option if you are unsure about what you are buying. They will know exactly what instrument brand and model you will need and will have different rental options that mail-order companies will not. They will also be able to do different repair/warranty deals.

Mail-Order Companies: This is the best option if you want to buy straight out without renting or financing, which in the long run could save you hundreds of dollars. These companies are well respected. Please be very specific about the brand and model you are looking for. Also, these companies may not have all the required accessories.

Facebook Marketplace, eBay, Pawn Shops: This option has the highest risk, but you could also get a great deal. I would not buy anything sight unseen without a money back guarantee! Also, ask the seller if you can have a “third party evaluation” done. This is where the seller takes the instrument to a reputable music shop, preferably one you pick, and has it inspected for quality. You then communicate directly to the shop rather than the seller. This can be a lot of extra work, but you might be able to get a great deal.

When you acquire the instrument, IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT that the student or other family members not be allowed to “play” the instrument before instruction has been given! Your child will develop bad habits that are very difficult to break, and the well-meaning family member may break the instrument or its accessories which could result in a costly repair or replacement.

Private Lessons

Private instruction is available for your child from local professional musicians. Private lessons are not required; however, they are strongly suggested and will give your child an opportunity to progress more quickly. A weekly lesson is 30 minutes long, and the average rate per lesson is \$18. Information will be given in August about signing up for private lessons.
